


Greensand

- > Quantity : up to 15,000 ts liquified Co2
- > Grade : food/consumable

 -30° at 15 bars pressure
- > Mode of transportation and offshore interfaces :
 - 80 x 20' cryoghanic ISO tank containers
 - 1 x platform supply vessel (converted)
 - 1 x jack-up drilling rig (interface)
 - 1 x stationary offshore installation



PSV initial storage proposal




PSV final stowage proposal




Offshore interface – side view






Offshore interface – side view







