Four National CPBs in Sweden

- The total volume of Public Procurement in Sweden: < 800 billion SEK
- Adda CPB – municipalities, regions & their companies
 - 30 PP in 2022
 - Turnover on FWA and DPS in 2022: 17 billion SEK
 - Regional CPB for Stockholm Area
- Central govts CPB at Kammarkollegiet, ICT also for municipalities/regions
 - 22 PP in 2022
 - Turnover on FWA in 2022: 16,4 billion SKE
- HBV – CPB for Housing Companies mainly owned by municipalitites
 - 14 PP in 2022
 - Turnover on FWA and DPS in 2021: 3 billion SEK
- Sinfra – CPB for Utilities Sector (municipalities or their companies)
 - 22 PP in 2022
 - Turnover on FWA 2021: 2,6 billion SEK

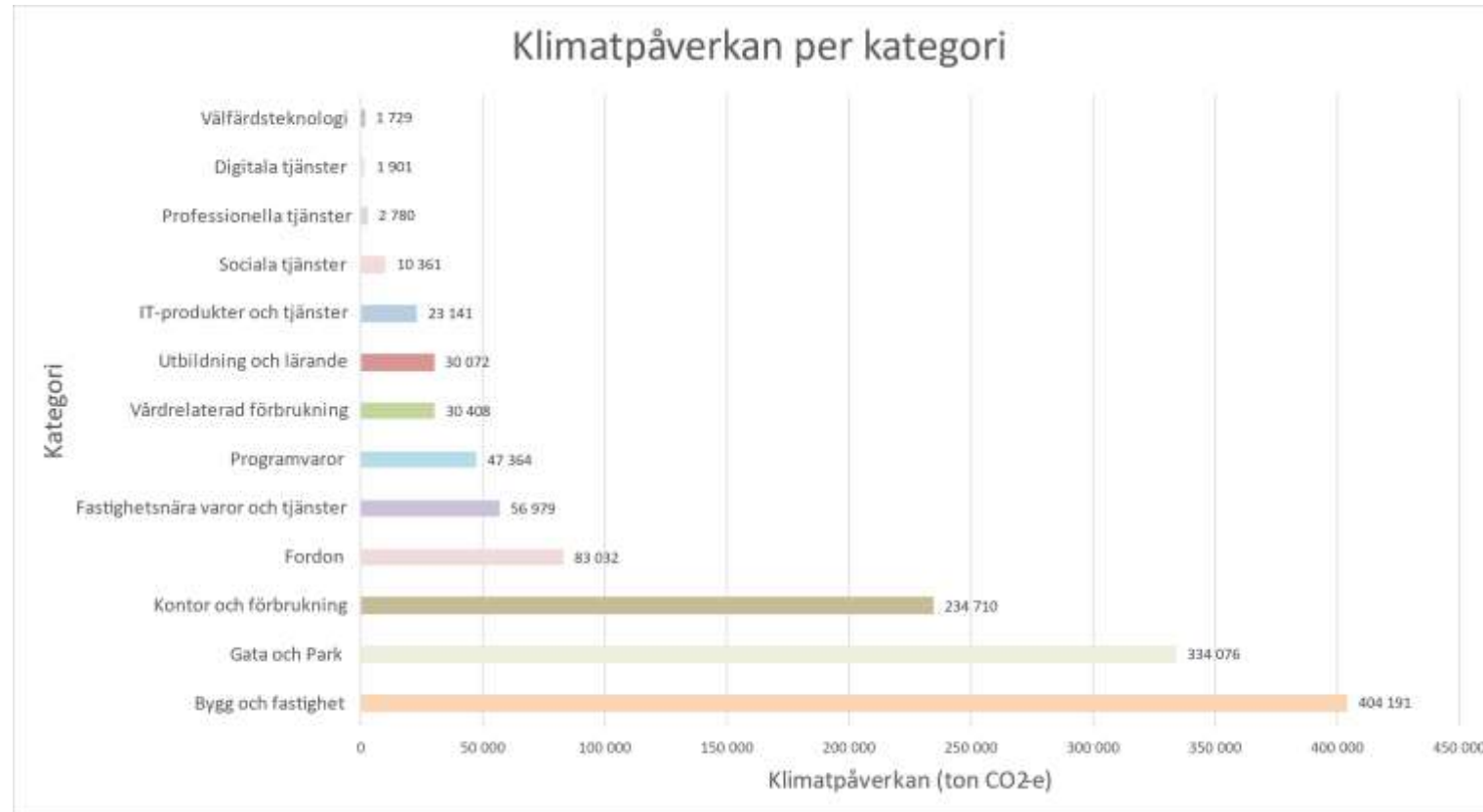
What do sustainability strategists do at Adda CPB?

- 10 % of municipalities' and regions' emissions are from purchases

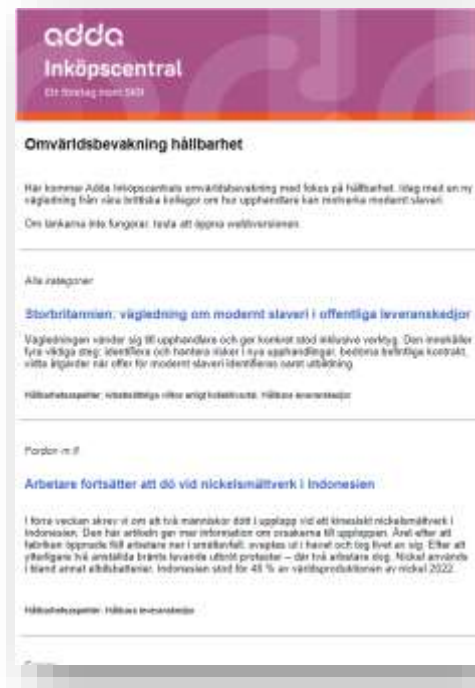

Sustainability year 2022

- Adda's own climate footprint 157 tons CO₂e (travel and energy)
- New principles for monitoring
- Method for sanctions due diligence
- 25 self-assessment questionnaires, 8 desk audits, 13 office audits, 24 re-audits and 3 dialogues within our regular monitoring of sustainable supply chains, and incident management of conflict minerals
- 4 suppliers monitored on labour conditions according to collective agreements
- Several environmental follow-ups including two on artificial turf
- Environmental spend analysis with IVL Swedish Environmental Research Institute
- 6 re-audits within the Sustainability Check (Hållbarhetskollen)
